

Kalamunda Environmental Advisory Committee 'Climate Change Report'

Scope of Services

The Kalamunda Environmental Advisory Committee (KEAC) is to prepare a report back to the Council of the City in response to the community motion passed at the Annual Meeting of Electors regarding Climate Change.

The following three main parts are proposed:

- A succinct, compelling 'impact statement' - statistical evidence on local impacts of climate change within the City's borders
- Description of positive steps that the City is making to manage the impacts
- Identify what more the City can do under existing strategies with resourcing implications

Tasks would include:

- Review the City's adopted Kalamunda Clean and Green Local Environment Strategy and provide commentary on actions undertaken and what further actions could be taken to address the matter
- Review and provide commentary regarding the impact that Local Governments can directly have and the impacts that the community directly have on emissions
- Review and provide commentary on the practicality of the City becoming carbon neutral and potential timelines
- Compare what other Local Governments are undertaking in this area
- Identify scientific analysis and reports on climate change that assist in understanding the impacts
- Estimate likely costs of additional actions
