Course Overview

SHB30315 The Certificate III in Nail Technology is a nationally recognised qualification under the Hairdressing and Beauty Services Training package (SHB).

This qualification has been designed for those individuals who wish to be employed as a nail technician to provide manicure and pedicure services, including the application and use of nail art, electric drill, acrylic and gel nail enhancements. These individuals possess a range of well-developed technical customer and service skills where discretion and judgement is required and are responsible for their own work outputs. This includes client consultations on nail care products and services. Nail technicians may also be self-employed and responsible for managing their own nail station. Work is typically conducted in a nail or beauty salon.

The Certificate III in Nail Technology may also be utilised as a stepping stone to higher qualifications in beauty therapy or related industries.

Course Duration

15 weeks – 3 days per week (Monday, Wednesday & Thursday)

Tuition Cost Payment Options

Payment: \$676.20 (payment in full OR payment plan option available) Funded by the WA Government Eligible persons must produce a current Health Care Card upon enrolment.

Included in cost – full acrylic kit, full gel kit, implement kit, all products, equipment and learners guides required to complete this qualification other than those listed under student requirements below.

Uniforms: WA Academy uniform top will be supplied and is to be worn with black professional pants and enclosed black shoes.

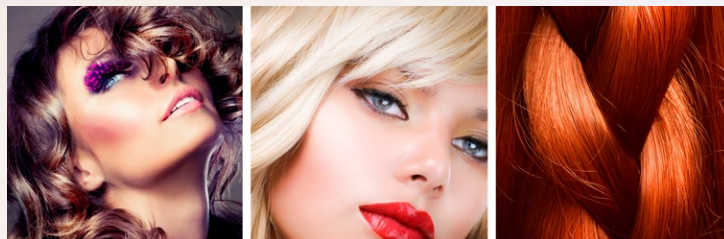

Course Overview

These two qualifications delivered together give any individual interested in a career in hairdressing, make-up, beauty or general retail an amazing head start and two fully accredited Certificate II qualifications. These preparation courses are a great introduction and taster into these fields and can lead to many employment or further study opportunities. The skills and knowledge are of an introductory level and are all undertaken under supervision including blowdrying, shampooing, makeup application day and evening, selling skills, basin skills, braiding hair and much much more.

This dual qualification can be used as a stepping stone into a hairdressing apprenticeship, retail outlets, makeup counter work or future studies in any of those areas.

Course Duration

15 weeks – 4 days per week (Monday – Wednesday Academy and Thursday compulsory work experience day).

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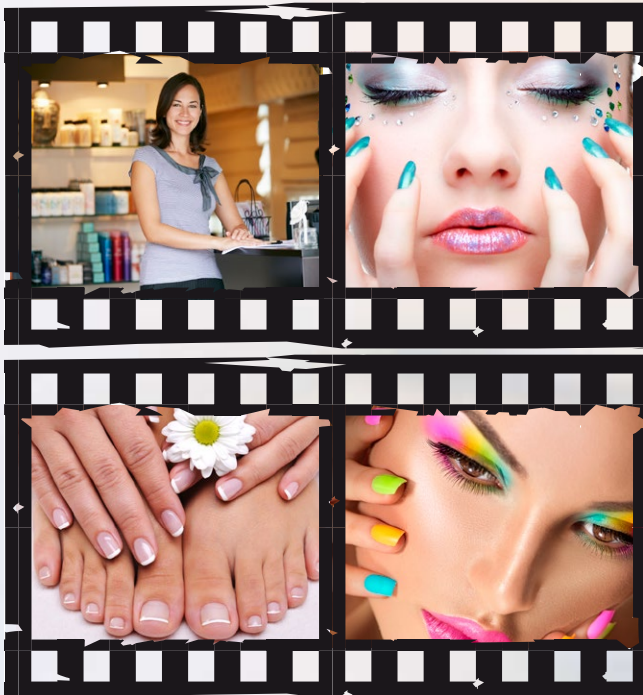
